PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in compliance with California Code of Regulations (CCR) Title 27, Section 21660.1(b), that Alameda County Department of Environmental Health, Office of Solid/Medical Waste Management, Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for CalRecycle has approved the Registration Permit application package to operate a Medium Volume Construction Demolition (CDI) Debris Processing Facility at Hayward Transfer Station, LLC.

Description of Registration Permit Application: Hayward Transfer Station, LLC filed a registration permit application to operate a Medium Volume Construction Demolition Inert (CDI) Debris Processing Facility at 3458 Enterprise Avenue, Hayward. The facility will accept up to 174 tons per day of CDI debris materials/wastes such as concrete, asphalt, roofing materials, metal, tile, glass, gypsum wallboard, etc. and will be open to the public Monday to Sunday 6 a.m. to 5 p.m., excluding holidays (Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day).

LEA Findings: The LEA accepted the application package as complete and correct on June 12, 2015, pursuant to 14 CCR, Chapter 5, Article 3, Section 18104.1. The Medium Volume CDI Debris Processing Facility is subject to the requirements of 14 CCR, Section 17383.5 and state minimum standards as set forth in 14 CCR, Division 7, Chapter 3.0, Section 17383 of Article 5.9, Article 6.2 and sections 17406.1, 17406.2 of Article 6.1 and 17414 of Article 6.3.
