Meeting notes

1. Discussed the concept plan for Kilcare-Sunol-wide community system alternatives 6 and 7, centered on the County-owned railroad lands

Provided detailed tables and diagrams on the amount of wastewater produced by district and the amount that can be dispersed at different locations (after treatment).

The County is supportive of using county land for dispersing waste water.

Existing septic tanks will be required to be water tight and compliant before hooking up to the system.

A community member asked that the homes on Railroad Road be included in the area defined by the downtown.

Several attendees said they thought the town should move ahead and that the consultant should narrow the study to just the project to provide a community leach field for the entire town.
