DAVIS STREET TRANSFER STATION

SOLID WASTE FACILITY PERMIT OPERATIONS SCHEDULE

To comply with the provisions of Title 14 CCR 17513 and at the direction of the LEA, the Davis Street Transfer Station submits this Operations Schedule. The purpose of this operations schedule is to satisfy the requirement that solid waste deposited at the site be removed every 48 hours or in accordance with an approved plan.

A solid waste mat or cushion is provided to protect the concrete pit bottom from damage by compactors and other heavy equipment. This mat is approximately twenty-four (24) inches in depth. The protective mat shall be removed weekly, typically on Friday, to reduce the potential of presenting a health hazard or public nuisance. Verification of the weekly removal of the mat will be recorded in the site log book. This information will be made available to the LEA upon request.

Transfer vehicles do not operate at the Davis Street Transfer Station on all weekends. Therefore, solid waste received on weekends may be stored for greater than 48 hours. Waste received on Friday will be used to rebuild the mat, with the remainder to be pushed to the front of the pit for disposal on the following Monday.

Waste material shall not be accumulated at a rate such that reuse will be stored for greater than 48 hours with the exception of waste received on Friday. Should the LEA determine this practice to present a potential or real health hazard or public nuisance, this schedule shall be adjusted.

Thank you for submitting the "Operation Schedule" where the verification of the weekly removal of all waste in the pit shall be documented in the site log. The removal of the 24" mat in the pit will typically occur on Friday. Please be aware that failure to do so will be considered a violation of the terms of operation.

This office finds that this schedule is approved provided that odors, vectors, rodents or other nuisances do not become problems. Should this occur, other actions must be taken to control the problem.
